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## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE in ORGANIZATIONAL MANAGEMENT

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### Pre-requisites

- Compliance with Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements in Reading, Writing and Math;
- Completed an approved (AAS) degree from a Texas college or equivalent;
- Students who are seeking admittance to the program must demonstrate satisfactory completion of the following PRIOR to admittance:
  - Completion of Admission to Midland College for the BAS/OM program through [www.goapplytexas.org](http://www.goapplytexas.org)
  - Completion of the B.A.S./O.M. application (<https://www.midland.edu/academics/media/documents/business-bas-om-application.pdf>)
  - ENGL 1301 (see “Note”)
  - A Speech course from the Core Curriculum list (see “Note”)
  - TSI complete in MATH (see “Note”)
  - An overall GPA of 2.0 or better in the A.A.S. curriculum

### NOTE the following:

- ECON 2301 should be completed before enrollment in TMGT 3337 is granted.  
(Completion of ECON 2301 is NOT required for program admission)
- ACCT 2301 OR ACNT 1403 should be completed before enrollment in TMGT 3338 is granted. (Completion of ACCT or ACNT courses is NOT required for program admission)
- Successful completion of upper-division courses requires a grade of "C" or better.

Students who are in their final semester of coursework earning their A.A.S. may enroll in no more than six (6) credit hours of upper-division courses, as long as the pre-requisites listed above have been completed and fulfilled.

To adequately prepare for the Finance, Accounting, and Economics courses and the writing requirements, it is strongly recommended ENGL 2311, SPCH 1321, and MATH 1324 be completed early in the program. These three courses are required on the BAS/OM degree plan.
