History: The Midland West Rotary Club, a club chartered in April 1962, and organized under the guidelines and precepts of Rotary International, the world's largest service organization, will grant scholarships to students who are currently enrolled at Midland College, or will be enrolling in one of the Applied Technology Programs. The Board of Directors of the Midland West Rotary Club will annually determine how many scholarships it will award each year as part of its annual budget process.

Purpose: The purpose of the Midland West Rotary Club Scholarship is to promote education and assist eligible students with the cost of tuition, fees, and books.

Amount of Scholarship: The scholarship amount can vary from year to year as determined by the Board of the Midland West Rotary Club. This year, students will receive a \$1,000 scholarship made payable to Midland College, with a memo referencing the student's name and MC student ID-pending confirmation of registration in the Career and Technology Program.

Eligibility: The applicant must be a graduating senior that is going to enroll at Midland College or already is enrolled in Midland College in one of the Career and Technology Fields.

Selection Process: Applications for the Midland West Rotary Club Scholarship can be obtained from the Department Chair of his or her respective field of study at Midland College. These application forms, along with transcripts and any attached letters of recommendation, should be completed and mailed or emailed to the Midland West Rotary Club Scholarship Committee at the address shown at the bottom of the page. The scholarship will be awarded based on the application and an interview.

Guidelines for Selection:

The applicant shall:

- 1) If a High School Graduate student, provide a transcript of classes taken during high school and grades earned along with a completed scholarship application form.
- 2) If a student is currently enrolled in Midland College, submit a transcript covering all classes taken at Midland College to the address at the bottom of this page.
- 3) Sit for an interview with the Scholarship Committee.

Requirements after Selection:

- 1) Enroll at Midland College for the next semester.
- 2) Apply the scholarship to tuition, fees, or supplies.
- 3) Attend one Rotary Meeting as our guest. Midland West Rotary Meets in the Rotary Room located in the MC Dining Hall every Tuesday at noon.
- 4) Endeavor to attain a G.P.A. of 2.5 or above on Midland College's 4.0 grading system.
