

Notice to Scholars' Dollars Recipients

Scholars' Dollars is a scholarship fund in which businesses throughout Fort Stockton donate to assist students pursuing higher education thru Midland College. This critical fund has assisted hundreds of Pecos County residents over the years and welcomes the opportunity to support Midland College students in pursuing their educational goals. This scholarship seeks to award a scholarship to students who desire to create a professional impact on their chosen fields.

Scholars' Dollars also reaches out to students in Continuing Education, such as, English as a Second language, Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), Pharmacy Technician and technical certificates.

The Scholars' Dollars Board is open to "special circumstances". The student may submit an explanation of their "financial hardship" in the attached essay of their application. The special circumstances should clearly identify and explain their specific circumstances and needs. Planning and knowing how to pay the expenses associated with enrolling in college courses is the students' responsibility. We understand life situations change and we welcome the opportunity to assist students in need.

Guidelines and Criteria

A. Before you apply:

1. Apply for admission to Midland College through www.goapplytexas.org.
2. Apply for federal financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov.
3. Attach a copy of your Midland College transcript if you have credit hours earned with Midland College or an outside college or university. An **unofficial copy** is acceptable for this scholarship.
4. After completing the application, keep this page and a copy of your application for your personal records.
5. Submit the completed application with your transcript (if applicable), confirmation of your SAI-Student Aid Index. (The SAI was formerly the EFC number associated with the financial information the student provided on the FAFSA), and essay to Josie Hernandez-Scholars' Dollars Coordinator.

B. Eligibility:

1. Pecos County residents to include Ft. Stockton and the surrounding area.
2. Eligible students may be awarded Scholars' Dollars for up to 60 credit hours. However, consideration based on a case by case need will be considered upon request.
3. Students should be enrolled for 6-8 credit hours (part time) to 12+ credit hours (full time).
4. To be eligible and remain eligible for a Scholars' Dollars award, a student must maintain a 2.0 GPA each semester.

C. Deadline:

1. Applications should be submitted no later than the **FIRST** week in **August** for the **FALL** semester.
2. Applications should be submitted no later than the **FIRST** week in **December** for the **SPRING** semester.
3. **No LATE applications will be accepted, strict adherence to the scholarship deadline is required.**

D. Selection Process:

1. Scholarship selection is made by the Scholars' Dollars Board.
2. Applications will be presented to the Board and will be identified by the last four digits of the student's Midland College ID number. Student name and identifying information is removed from the application.
3. The SD Board will consider all the information on the application and gives much weight to the essay question. Therefore, it is important that your information be concise and accurate. Students are encouraged to take their time to plan and document their situation fully.
4. After the SD Board's consideration of the application, the amount of scholarship, if any, will be determined for each applicant.
5. A scholarship award letter will be provided to the student by the Scholars' Dollars Coordinator.
